### Scavenger Hunt Stop: Garland Theatre

An art deco delight, fun to enjoy a movie day or night.

**Fun Fact:** When the Garland Theatre opened in November of 1945 it was the premiere movie house of the west.

**Activity:** Imagine you could make your own movie... What would it be called? Who would be some of the characters? Where would it take place? Make your own movie poster if you like! ✨

### Scavenger Hunt Stop: Corbin Park

Oval shaped and tree lined this park is surrounded by historic houses

**Fun Fact:** The oval shape of this park was once a racetrack. from its time as Spokane's 1st fairgrounds.

**Activity:** The Corbin Park Mural shows Spokane landmarks and images from the artist's Filipino culture. What important things would you add to a mural of your own? Why? 🌻

### Scavenger Hunt Stop: The Milk Bottle

You can't miss this giant white bottle while walking along Garland.

**Fun Fact:** Built in 1935 by the Benewah Dairy Company this giant milk bottle was "designed to build better men and women by making dairy products attractive to boys and girls".

**Activity:** This giant milk bottle is 38 feet tall! Count out 38 steps as you walk along...what giant food would you want to be that big, to go with your milk?

### Scavenger Hunt Stop: Brick Buy Brick

A locally owned business devoted to everyone's favorite building blocks!

**Fun Fact:** The Lego companies signature interlocking plastic bricks were first introduced in 1949 as "Automatic Binding Bricks"

**Activity:** Explore the shop and use your imagination to build something on their "off the wall" challenge. Check their calendar for upcoming events.

### Scavenger Hunt Stop: Garland Art Alley

An open air gallery filled with colors and characters

**Fun Fact:** The Garland neighborhood boasts a growing collection of over 30 art pieces!

**Activity:** Play a game of "I spy" while walking along and looking at the murals. Which one is your favorite...why??

### Scavenger Hunt Stop: Giant Nerd Books

A unique used book store filled with a collection of curiosa and oddball miscellany

**Fun Fact:** Many lizards can regrow their tail after losing them to predators, the new tail is not an exact replica, it is made of cartilage rather than bone.

**Activity:** If you could have the creature power of any wild animal, what would it be? Can you draw a picture about it...
