## NEIGHBORHOOD SCAVENGER HUNT



**Scavenger Hunt Stop: Catalyst Building**  
Green energy in action this place is an example of building for a better future

**Fun Fact:** The innovative Catalyst building is designed to be one of the largest zero-carbon, zero-energy buildings in North America.

**Activity:** Explore the outside deck that looks out over the U-District. Play a game of "I-Spy" to describe what you see! Do you see anything that starts with a "T" -sound?

**Scavenger Hunt Stop: Gateway Bridge**  
Walk under the 120 foot arch and enjoy the sights of our city in action below

**Fun Fact:** The name of this bridge was selected through a public contest that received 281 submissions...what would you want to name the bridge?

**Activity:** This pedestrian and bicycle only bridge crosses the BNSF railway tracks below. How many different kinds of transportation can you find from here? What is your favorite kind? Why??

**Scavenger Hunt Stop: Sculptures at WSU Spokane Riverpoint Campus**  
Crossing the bridge you'll arrive at an open space with art all around

**Fun Fact:** While the cougar is now the symbol of WSU it wasn't always the mascot; animals first appeared on their game field in 1903, beginning with a dog named Squirt.

**Activity:** Pretend you are the artist that created one of these sculptures: What would you call it? Why? Play with making up names for the different art you see!

**Scavenger Hunt Stop: Jundt Art Museum at Gonzaga**  
Enjoy a room with a river view and a chandelier of red cascading glass.

**Fun Fact:** The Gonzaga Chandelier was made by world renowned artist Dale Chihuly. The chandelier is about 18 feet long and 6 feet wide, weighing almost 2,000 pounds!

**Activity:** Sit under the chandelier and draw what you see.

**Scavenger Hunt Stop: Donut Parade**  
Neighbors and friends come together here for a sweet treat

**Fun Fact:** In 1847 American Ship Captain Hanson Gregory invented the ring shape by punching out the raw center to ensure even cooking.

**Activity:** Sing the counting song: 5 Little donuts in the bakery shop, 5 little donuts with sprinkles on top, Along came \_\_\_\_\_ with a penny to pay, They grabbed 1 Donut and took it away!  
Count down each time...

**Scavenger Hunt Stop: Global Neighborhood Thrift and Vintage.** All are welcome at this amazing second hand store with staff from around the world

**Fun Fact:** *Global Neighborhood* was founded in 2008 to provide long-term support to the roughly 500-1000 refugees per year that have been resettling in Spokane

**Activity:** Check out the great used book section...how many different languages can you find?
